



## Doctoral Fellowship

An interdisciplinary team of computer scientists, economists and sociologists is looking for a highly skilled and motivated *doctoral* student in economics or management to participate in a newly funded project (Scientific Networks and IDEX Funding) that will examine the impact of *Initiative d'Excellence* (IDEX) funding programme on research outcomes across France.

The project is based in the South of France at universities and research organizations located in Nice and Sophia Antipolis. Together these institutions constitute a newly formed IDEX University (Université Côte d'Azur). Please see the attached project proposal (the expected doctoral student contributions are described on page 7).

The ideal candidate is someone who has (i) a strong quantitative background, (ii) strong computer skills including programming, (iii) the ability to work independently to solve problems, and (iv) a long-term interest in pursuing research in economics, management, and related fields. A successful candidate already enrolled in a US or European doctoral program may perform most of his/her work at his/her home institution.
